## **Job Posting: *Summer Visitor Counsellor | Guide***

**Employer:** Sooke Region Museum & Visitor Centre

Terms: \$13.26 hr, with a start date in mid May.

**Tasks:** Provide information to visitors on the many attractions, events, businesses and activities in the region. Provide interpretive tours of on-site heritage attractions, including possibly acting as an historical person. Assist with youth and adult programs. Assist with one of the region's major special events, the Annual Open House & Salmon BBQ. Assist with the collection of statistical information on tourist in the region. Assist with Facebook & Twitter accounts; work on our database of heritage and community information. Assist newcomers to the community with information of services in the region. Promote responsible use of the region's environment by visitors.

**Qualifications:** This position is funded by federal government summer student grants that have specific rules about who can be hired. To be eligible, students must:

- be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment;
- have been registered as full-time students in the previous academic year and intend to return to school on a full-time basis in the next academic year;
- be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act*<sup>2</sup>; and,
- be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations.
